- The life and health science sector has been expanding since 2016 and is expected to continue
- Digital and IT sectors are expected to grow substantially in Wiltshire, especially with cyber security and the security forces based in Wiltshire.
- Manufacturing and Engineering – due to local policy by Wiltshire Council in promoting low carbon technology and green energy, it is expected that this sector will develop further.
