September Covid-19 testing arrangements

Further to my letter last week regarding lateral flow testing on our return to school in September, please see below details of the timings for testing for Years 12 and 13. As a reminder, for test one students should come in to school for their test and go home again. They will return to school on 2nd September for their interview/induction day before starting their lessons on Friday 3rd. Test two will be taken during the school day and students will leave their class as a group and return to lessons after the test.
