Starting February 2022, we are looking to appoint a technician to work within our Design Technology Faculty. The ideal candidate will be skilled in the use of wood, metal and plastic in a workshop environment. Full training will be provided to improve skills, if required, and Health and safety training will be undertaken in all areas of machine use. First Aid at Work Certificate would be an advantage although full training will be offered.

Duties will include:

- preparing materials ready for lessons
- maintaining tools and equipment
- ensuring a safe environment and supporting teachers in practical lessons
- maintaining displays and other administrative tasks related to the smooth running of the Faculty, such as managing stock levels
- supporting students' learning in the workshops, including supervising the use of machines
- First Aid support.
